

Kinds/types of PAPER in a Junk Journal Signature...	yes
Plain/not enhanced copy paper or cardstock	
Tea or coffee stained paper	
Papers in different colors	
Enhanced: painted, dyed, eco-dyed images, textured etc.	
Magazine pages	
Printed word book pages – fiction/non-fiction/instructional	
Scrapbook paper – designs or textured	
Digital images printed on paper – including kits/themes etc.	
Atlas pages or maps	
Light weight paper – vellum/tracing/painters/baking etc.	
Doilies or paper cut to shapes, etc.	
Dictionary or Encyclopedia pages	
Music Paper	
Lined paper meant for writing – notebook or correspondence	
Graph paper	
Ledger Paper	
Bags – vellum, paper, glassine, etc.	
Envelopes – junk mailers, window envelopes, etc.	

What is a “Signature”?

A junk journal “signature” is a group of pages cut or folded to fit inside a cover.

The pages/paper can be uniform or differ in size. They can be all one kind of paper or varied.

In a junk journal there can be as few signatures as one and as many as the spine width can hold.

Junk journaling is about personality – not perfection! Make it yours.
